On August 18, 2006, Conor was taken to a doctor for showing a substantial drop in energy. He was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. Treatment began immediately. Conor has passed through the induction phase of treatment and is now in

7 months of consolidation chemotherapy, to be followed by 3 years of maintenance chemotherapy.

Conor is an 11-year-old straight-A student, is in his fourth year of piano lessons, and is an avid golfer. He has been golfing competitively since he was 7 years old, and this past summer he won 8 of 14 tournaments, including one just 2 weeks before his diagnosis. He is the 2006 Oregon State Junior Match Play Champion (Pee Wee Division), which is a major competition that is an important stepping stone to collegiate and professional golfing. He also won the Portland City - Bob Allard Memorial Championship by 6 strokes. A truly remarkable human being.

Conor lives in Sandy on a family farm settled by his great-grandparents. He lives there with his mom, Melody; his dad, David; his 9-year-old sister, Elliette; and his 7-year-old sister, Etienne. He attends The Phonics Phactory in Gresham.
