Directions to Doernbecher

From Downtown Portland to Doernbecher: On SW Broadway get into the far right-hand lane as you pass Portland State University and stay in the far right-hand lane, which will peel off to the right, heading southbound on SW 6th Avenue.

Stay straight on Sam Jackson Park Road, and follow through campus. At the fork in the road, stay to the right, and the OHSU Auditorium parking lot will be on your right. Parking is free, and the entrance to the building faces the fountain in front.

From Downtown Portland to the South Waterfront: The tram is located at the OHSU Center for Health and Healing at 3303 SW Bond Avenue, on the west side of the Willamette River just south of the Ross Island Bridge. Parking will be available in the center's garage. From downtown Portland, take Harrison St. east, cross Naito Parkway and turn right onto SW Moody. Turn left on Curry, left again on Bond and a final left on Whitaker to the parking garage entrance. Parking is \$3 per day in the garage, or \$1.60 per hour for limited street parking. From the garage, proceed to the tram. **Tram tickets will not be provided this year.** Please note it is a 10-15 minute walk from the tram to the OHSU Auditorium.
