### Helmets are required

All skill levels are welcome. There are two  
distances to choose from: 61 & 25 miles.

All rides begin and end at Sturdivant Park in  
Coquille. There are no steep grades on any  
of the rides and all types of bicycles are  
welcome. Choose the ride that fits your  
schedule and your comfort zone.

This lovely “out and back” tour will take you  
through rolling hills, past farms and beautiful  
country scenery.

Support is available. All check and turnaround  
points will have water and sanitation available.  
Medical support, communications and bike  
repair will be provided throughout the tour.  
Enjoy a BBQ at the finish line. Celebrate your  
ride and support for children’s cancer research  
with a BBQ lunch at lovely Sturdivant Park.
