The outstanding dedication and generosity of all of you helps enable the staff at Doernbecher to provide the most advanced therapies to children battling cancer.

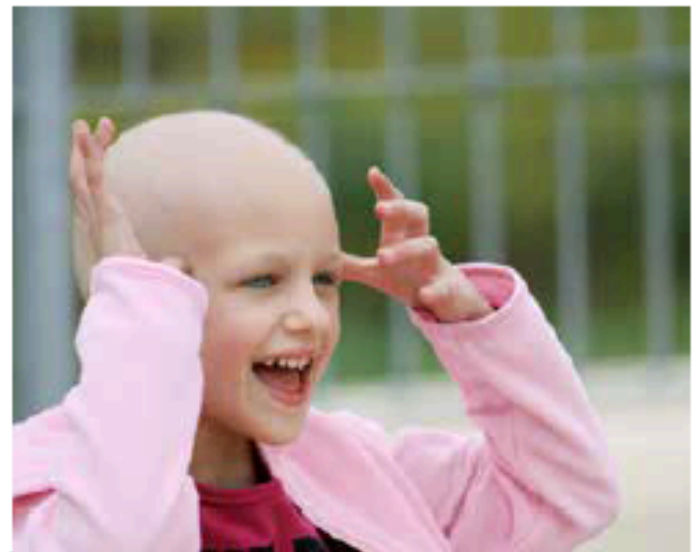
Doernbecher Children's Hospital is one of only 21 institutions in the nation - and one of only four west of the Mississippi River - designated as a Phase 1 pediatric research hospital by the National Cancer Institute. This designation means that the children of Oregon and southwest

Washington have access to the newest pediatric cancer treatments before they are more widely available.

As the pediatric arm of Oregon Health & Science University, its staff conducts world-class research into childhood illnesses and trains tomorrow's pediatricians.

DCH cares for the majority of Oregon's young cancer patients and is the only provider of bone marrow / stem cell transplants in Oregon and southwest Washington.

Without Doernbecher, children would have to go to Seattle or San Francisco for comparable care. It is the premier children's hospital in Oregon and southwest Washington, and provides the widest range of healthcare services for children in the region.
